

More Things You Should Know About Downtown Janesville...

Downtown Revolving Loan Program This program was authorized by the Janesville City Council in June of 2014 with an initial investment of \$54,000. The City's investment was made through the appropriation of proceeds from retiring Tax Increment Finance districts, and is being supplemented by matching \$10,000 commitments from each of the following local lending institutions: Blackhawk Community Credit Union, BMO Harris Bank, Blackhawk Bank, Johnson Bank, and First National Bank and Trust. This program is available to eligible applicants seeking to make improvements to buildings they own or operate out of in Downtown Janesville. Eligible activities include façade renovation, creation/improvement of upper story residential units, investments in commercial tenant spaces, and more. Applicants are required to coordinate a pre-application conference with the program officer prior to submitting an application. All completed applications will be reviewed by the Revolving Loan Review Committee, which meets on the first Thursday of the month at 1 pm at Janesville City Hall. Permits are required for many downtown building renovation projects. Before beginning an interior or exterior renovation, contact the City of Janesville Building and Development Services Division at (608) 755-3060 to see if your project needs a permit.

Downtown Clean-up Days are held twice a year in May and September. Downtown and community volunteers work in teams to perform seasonal maintenance and cleaning on the public spaces. Private property owners are encouraged to make improvements to their properties on these days. For information on clean-up days, email downtownjanesville@gmail.com.

Downtown Redevelopment and Reinvestment Assistance The City of Janesville utilizes its Tax Increment Finance authority to facilitate redevelopment projects in the downtown in a number of creative ways. In addition, the City administers a Revolving Loan program which provides low-interest financing for improvements to existing downtown buildings.

Downtown Janesville Incorporated (DJI) is made up of local business people who in conjunction with key team members within the City of Janesville, and other local agencies, provides direction and organization for the continued growth and development of Janesville's historic downtown. DJI board meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month. For more information, visit DowntownJanesville.com.

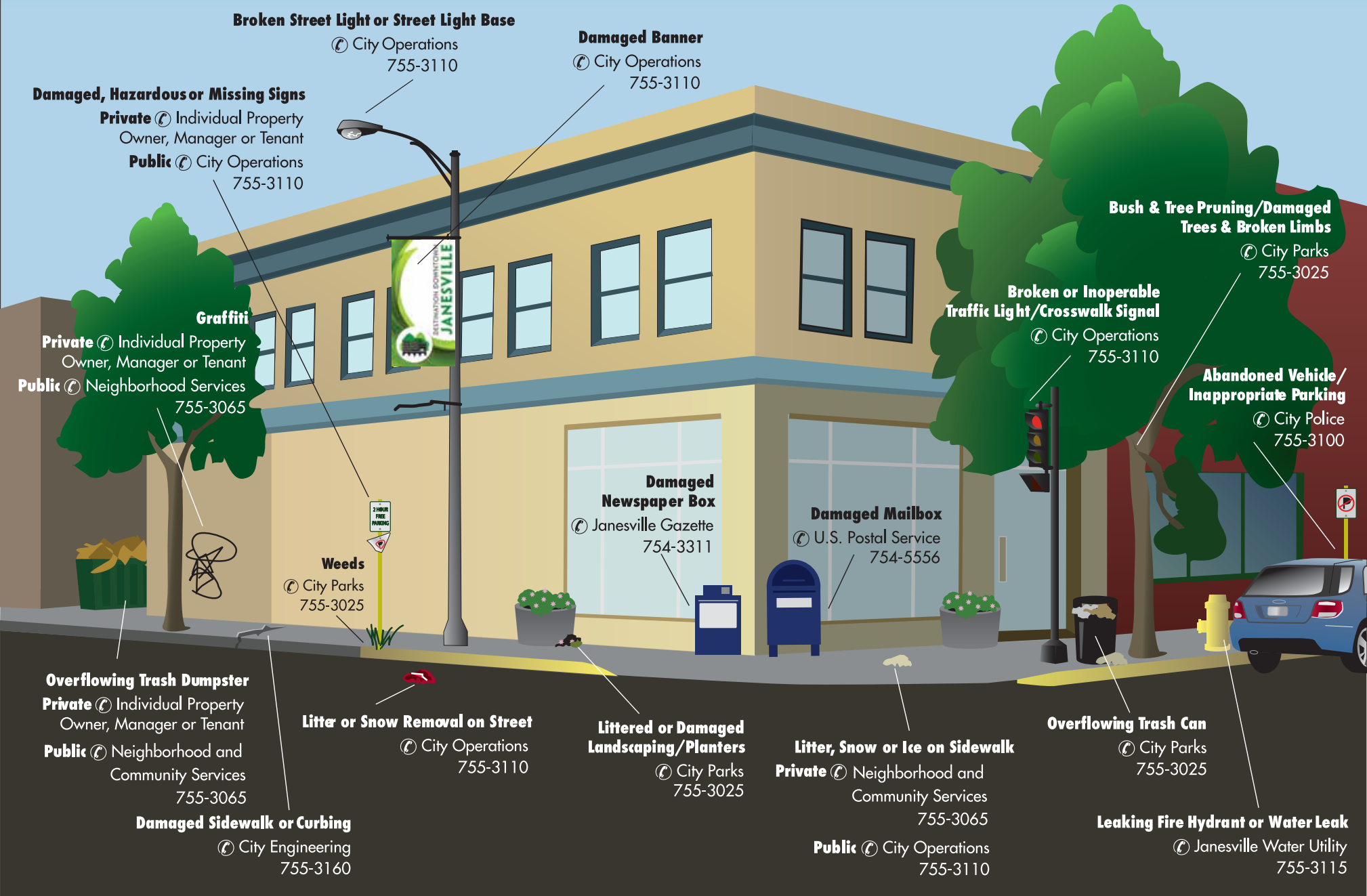
